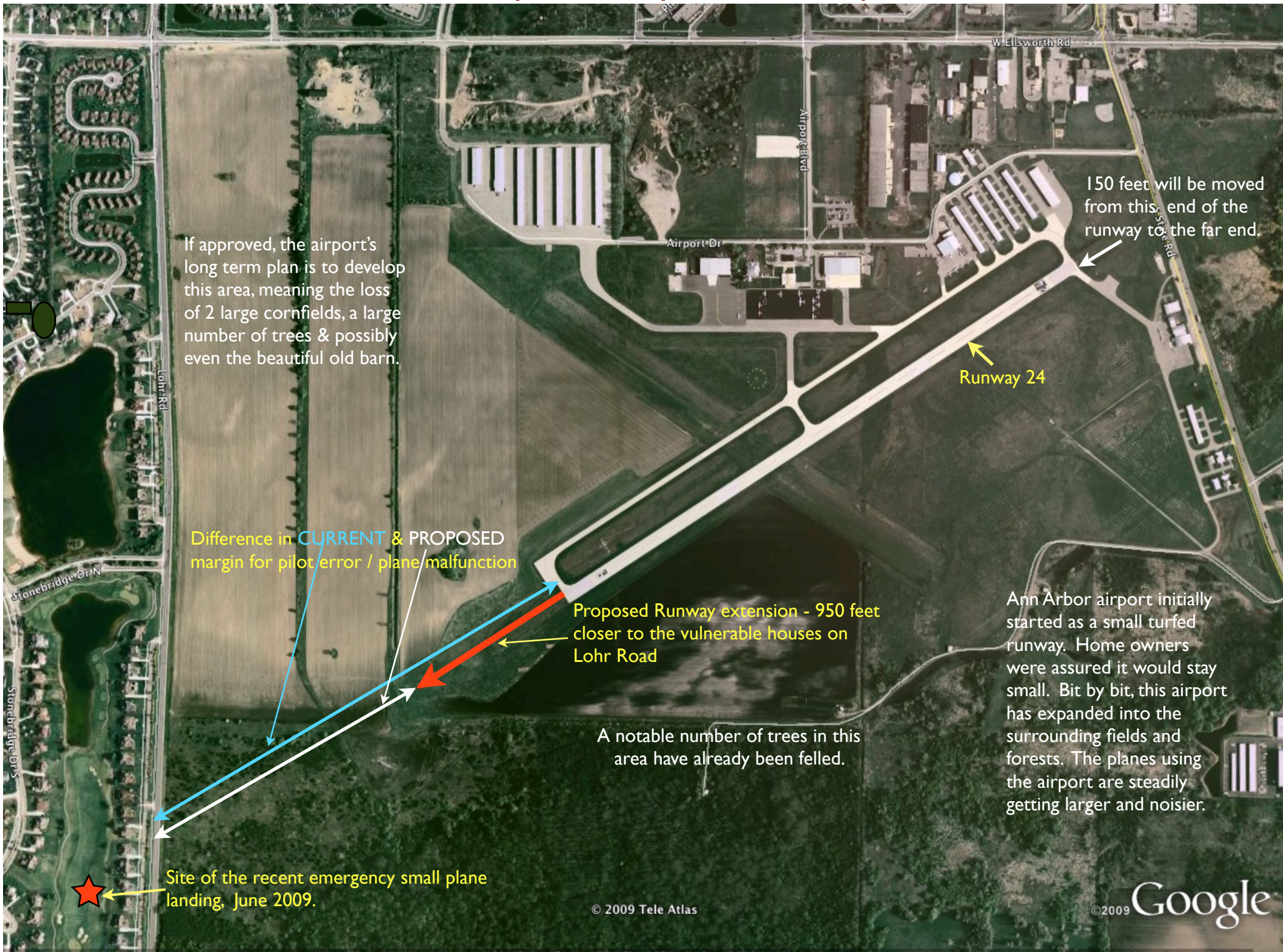


Ann Arbor Airport's Expansion Proposal



If approved, the airport's long term plan is to develop this area, meaning the loss of 2 large cornfields, a large number of trees & possibly even the beautiful old barn.

150 feet will be moved from this end of the runway to the far end.

Difference in **CURRENT** & **PROPOSED** margin for pilot error / plane malfunction

Proposed Runway extension - 950 feet closer to the vulnerable houses on Lohr Road

A notable number of trees in this area have already been felled.

Ann Arbor airport initially started as a small turfed runway. Home owners were assured it would stay small. Bit by bit, this airport has expanded into the surrounding fields and forests. The planes using the airport are steadily getting larger and noisier.
